

Oak wood



European oak

- Slow growth – at least 160 years
- Dark, robust wood with firm structure
- Rich and intensive in tannins
- Dispenses rich and strong aroma to the distillate
- Open-air drying for two to three years



American oak

- Faster growth compared to European oak, until approx. 70 years
- Light, delicate wood
- Primarily dispenses vanilla aromas
- Dispenses smooth and subtle aroma
- Wood is dried very quickly, mostly industrial
